### PLASTICIENS VOLANTS: **PERLE** **HF**

On this year's Night of the Arts, the French street theatre company Plasticiens Volants will transform Helsinki's city centre sky into an enormous ocean aquarium. Giant floating sea creatures will swim from Esplanadi to the Senate Square, telling their aquatic tale along the way.

Medusa, whales, fish and sea snakes will float overhead to a musical score by Philippe Bonnet. Also appearing in the parade is the Finnish Bad Ass Brass Band.

The cavalcade departs from Esplanadi by the Swedish Theatre at 9pm towards the Senate Square. A programme of entertainment will be on offer at the square for the duration of the parade from 9pm onwards. The urban extravaganza culminates in an hour-long grand finale at the Square, starting at approximately 9.30pm.

This urban extravaganza is brought to you by Helsinki Festival and Helsingin Sanomat.
